Dear Parents and Guardians,

Does your child spend too much time playing video games? Do you miss the days when they would get together with their friends and just use their imagination? Cripple Creek-Victor Jr/Sr High is proud that they will host a Role Playing Game Club again this year. RPG Club will be for students 6th-12th grade and will meet every Wednesday from 4:15-6 after school.

An RPG is a “board game” style activity that allows the players to imagine parts of gameplay. Each specific RPG has its own rules and regulations that set guidelines for how players achieve a common goal. Their goal could be slaying a dragon, freeing a village from an evil Mage, or delivering a mattress across a perilous mountain pass. The only limitation is what the players can imagine. If they want their character to parkour up a two story building, they roll a 20 sided dice to simulate a random outcome.

Additionally, students who participate in tabletop RPG’s show improved social and academic skills. Socially, kids who play RPGs have to work cooperatively together and it gives an opportunity to interact with others in a safe environment, trying out new methods of speech and coping skills. Academically, they’re reading, they creatively solving problems, they’re researching, and they’re even doing a little light math when they consider the probability of the roll of the dice and adding statistics. Studies show that playing RPGs can boost learning and stimulate intellectual curiosity and growth.

We ask that the players provide their own playing materials when possible, which may include a basic rulebook, notebook, pencil, and a set of polysided dice. Some players may want to purchase these materials so that they can bring them home, if they don’t already own them. However, such purchases are not required, and there will be a limited number of materials available to share during our gaming sessions. We will also use an online resource, [dndbeyond.com](http://dndbeyond.com), during club time that offers these materials digitally.
