RE: 2022-23 School Year Information

Welcome Back CC-V Families,

Please read the following information carefully and keep a copy for your future reference.

COVID Updates:

CC-V School District (CCVSD) is following the most recent guidance from Center for Disease Control (CDC) regarding COVID-19. We ask that anyone who is sick to stay home and get tested. If you test positive, isolate for 5 days from the day of symptom onset. You can end the isolation period after five days, if you are symptom free and/or fever free for 24 hours. If you are exposed to someone who has tested positive, we ask that you wear a mask and monitor for symptoms.

We will monitor COVID-19 case rates and continue to work closely with Teller County Public Health Department to assess and take appropriate action, as necessary.

CCVSD encourages our students, families and staff members to become vaccinated, although doing so will remain an individual choice. CCVSD will not require COVID vaccinations to attend class or student activities.

Stay Home If Sick or Exposed:

If your child is not feeling well or has COVID symptoms, PLEASE STAY HOME! Contact the front office to report the absence. If your child tests positive for COVID or has been in close contact with a confirmed case, please stay home, contact the front office and Teller County Public Health.

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Transportation:

CCVSD is continuing our partnership with Durham School Services to provide morning and afternoon bus transportation for our students. If your child is going to ride the bus, please inform the front office to register them and make sure you have a copy of the **new routes/times** (available on our website and in both front offices). This year, we are only running two buses- the Moose and the Cowboy.

Bus transportation is a privilege. It is vital to the safety of our students, our bus drivers and other motorists that students behave appropriately on the bus. Any student who violates bus rules and/or behaves in a way that risks the safety of themselves or others, may lose bus privileges.

Contact Information & School Messages/Alerts:

Make sure your child's school has your current contact information, including an emergency contact. School messages will be sent out through **Infinite Campus** via email, phone call and/or text message. **FlashAlert** (download the app) will be used to announce weather delays, closures and/or school emergencies.
