Dear Parent/Guardian:

Your request for admission to the Cripple Creek-Victor School District has been accepted on a conditional basis. However, should it be subsequently determined that answers are inaccurate on the enrollment questionnaire, or if you:

- 1) Are out of district and have a physical or mental disability such that you cannot reasonably benefit from the programs available;
- 2) Are out district and have a physical or mental disability or disease causing the attendance of you to be inimical to the welfare of other pupil;
- 3) Have graduated from the 12th grade or any school or have received a document evidencing completion of the equivalent of a secondary curriculum (i.e. a GED);
- 4) Fail to meet the requirements of age, i.e., have not reached the age of six at a time after the beginning of school year fixed by the Board of Education, or have reached the age of 21;
- 5) Have been expelled from any school district during the preceding 12 months or have engaged in behavior in another school district during the previous 12 months that is detrimental to the welfare or safety of other pupils or to school personnel;
- 6) Have failed to comply with the provisions of part 9 of article 4 of title 25, C.R.S. ("School Entry Immunization);

Then your conditional admission shall be revoked and you shall be denied admission to the school district.
